Charles Dickens	<p><b>PROPOSED WAITING RESTRICTIONS - TURNER ROAD</b></p> <p>Following an assessment of the crossing facilities outside Ark Dickens Primary School it was identified that some improvements were needed to the existing facilities on Turner Road. The drainage at the existing crossing was presenting a slip hazard and the existing on street parking restrictions were not preventing cars from being parked at the raised table that the school crossing patrol (SCP) uses.</p> <p>The Traffic Regulation Order (TRO) team is currently seeking consent to advertise "no waiting at any time" restrictions (double yellow lines) in place of existing "no waiting Monday to Friday 8am - 5pm" restrictions on Turner Road outside Ark Dickens Primary School. The introduction of this restriction would help ensure that the crossing point outside the school is kept clear at all times, to enhance road safety.</p> <p>If you have any comments or concerns about this proposal, please contact the case officer indicated, quoting the reference number P051-24. If the TRO team does not hear from you within 7 calendar days of the date of this MIS paper (i.e. by 23 August 2024), they will commence the formal public consultation process. The formal consultation period for these proposed measures will span the statutory 21 days and will involve advertising the changes in the press, on the PCC website, notices posted on street furniture, and letter drops to properties directly affected by the proposals.</p> <p>All representations received in response to the formal consultation will be assessed, and all objections reported to the Cabinet Member for Transport at a Transport Cabinet Decision meeting; the Cabinet Member can either decide that the Order is made (wholly or in part), or not made. Alternatively, the Cabinet Member for Transport can defer the decision to a later meeting.
