With regards to the impact of the proposed use upon the living conditions of adjoining occupiers, the level of activity associated with the use of any individual property as a Class C4 HMO (accommodating up to 6 people) is unlikely to be materially different to the use of a single household as a Class C3 dwelling house occupied by either a single family or other groups living as a single household. Having regard to the lack of any other HMO uses in the locality, the impact of one HMO is not considered likely to give rise to any adverse impacts on the balance of uses within the surrounding community. It is therefore considered that the use of this property for C3/C4 purposes would not have a detrimental impact upon the living conditions of local residents. Internal alterations would need to be the subject of a planning application should they exceed permitted development allowances. Loss of property values are not a material planning consideration.
